Subject: Grant of Yearly Permission to Nizamia Unani Medical College & Hospital, Dumri, P.O. Rasalpur, Via-Buniyadganj Distt. Gaya-823003, Bihar (Inst. Id.: - UNI0280) with intake capacity of 34 seats (instead of 40 seats) in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulation thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Nizamia Unani Medical College & Hospital, Dumri, P.O. Rasalpur, Via-Buniyadganj Distt. Gaya-823003, Bihar (Inst. Id.: - UNI0280)** inspection was conducted on **04.06.2026 & 05.06.2026 via Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **annual visitation for issuance of permission with intake capacity of 40 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- 2) Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the "Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the Visitor Observation, various shortcoming/defects have been observed regarding Teaching, Non-Teaching, Hospital Staff, and Infrastructure same was placed in the 165th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 24.07.2026 and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college.**
- 3) In view of above an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 18.08.2026** was granted to your college to appear on **20.08.2026** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the permission to your college with intake capacity of 40 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 be denied.**
- 4) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter. Ref. No. 295/NUMCH/26 dated 19.08.2026** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Principal of the college Dr. Shamshad Alam,** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **20.08.2026** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college.
- 5) Thereafter, observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms regulations, namely, "Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, the observation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **173rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 21.08.2026** and Board concluded that the **college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission in accordance with regulation 16 (2)(a) of MESAR UG Unani regulations, 2023, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and as per the approved Punitive Policy for the Academic session 2026-27.**

❖ **As per the "Punitive Policy for the academic session 2026-27":-**

- i) **"For each deficient teaching faculty, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 5% of total intake capacity."**

As per the observation of hearing committee there is shortcoming of 1 LF in each department of Ilmul Advia, Moalajat and Ilmul Atfal respectively.

There is deficiency of total 03 teaching faculties, therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 15% of total intake capacity (i.e. Reduction of 06 seats).

Accordingly, after applying the punitive policy for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act, 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **yearly permission with intake capacity of 34 seats (instead of 40 seats) in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**

"DECISION"

- 6) **Therefore, Yearly Permission with seat reduction is hereby granted to Nizamia Unani Medical College & Hospital, Dumri, P.O. Rasalpur, Via-Buniyadganj Distt. Gaya-823003, Bihar (Inst. Id.:- UNI0280) with intake capacity of 34 seats (instead of 40 seats) in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and subject to the condition that the following requirements shall be fulfilled:-**
- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters with vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 10) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-28:-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for the Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
- 11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.
- 12) Further, in case you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal addressed to the Chairman, NCISM as per concerned Act and regulations.

Note: It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
